

# CHANDRAGUPTA Errata & Clarifications

## CHANDRAGUPTA Rule Book

**(4.53) Clarification:** CH and EL Nayaka can issue Individual Orders top LI if the Nayaka are eligible to command a mixed CH/LI or EL/LI line in that particular scenario.

**(4.54)** Add to #3: “If the die roll is higher, the Nayaka is Finished.”

**(7.32) #2:** Replace with: “Any unit issued Fire (only) orders, or a unit that changed facing per 7.25, or those simply within the activated Leader’s command range, may choose to attack all enemy combat units in their ZOCs. See the introduction to 9.1.”

**(8.23)** Add: “The non-phasing player cannot use both Entry Reaction and Return Fire at the same unit.”

**(9.16) Clarification:** In cases where a player has more than one unit is involved, the player picks the unit (not Type) that will be used in the determination. This choice determines the angle of attack.

**(9.18) Clarification:** A unit’s total accumulated hits is used in the determination, not just the hits incurred in that Shock combat

**(11.22)** 3<sup>rd</sup> sentence should be: “No Movement points are expended, but the unit must take *the most direct path* towards his Retreat Edge that is not blocked by enemy units, enemy ZOC (unless occupied by a friendly unit), or impassable terrain, even if this means moving into and/or through friendly units”

**(11.26)** Replace with: “The movement of Routing units through or into other units is covered on the Stacking Charts [6.78]. The main premise is that routed units may not stack. If a routed unit were to finish its rout movement in a friendly-occupied hex, instead, and as per the chart, it continues on one more hex. If that additional hex is also occupied, the routed unit is automatically eliminated. The non-moving unit in that hex incurs the penalties indicated on the chart.”

**(11.28) #5:** Replace with: “Routed units that incur any additional cohesion hits are immediately eliminated and removed from play.”

**(13.0) Clarification:** EL units are worth RPs equal to their TQ.

## CHANDRAGUPTA Playbook

PATALIPUTRA

Setup Map: Mauryan Left Flank Elephants should be one row back (34XX); there should *not* be an empty hex intervening between the Mauryan Left Wing and Left Flank. There should *not* be an empty hex intervening between the Nandan Left Flank and the Left Wing, nor between the Nandan Front and the Right Wing.

Setup up map: Patrocles is a SC

### **CHANDRAGUPTA Charts**

**Shock Superiority Chart:** SK are AS against Chariots [CH]

**Elephant Rampage Table:** 7-9 result, 2<sup>nd</sup> bullet – delete the 2<sup>nd</sup> sentence. There are no leader Elephants
